

## **Ruth Gani Travelling Fellowship**

### **Call for Applications**

Applications from current postgraduate students in JCSMR for the Ruth Gani Travelling Fellowship for 2009 are invited and should reach the Student Officer, HR management section by 2 October.

This Fellowship is named in memory of Ruth Gani, a cytogeneticist at the Woden Valley Hospital who had been a School Visitor in the Human Genetics Group, John Curtin School of Medical Research and active member of that department. It is made available through a generous donation from Prof Joe Gani and the VC's Endowment for Excellence funds.

Normally, one Fellowship of up to \$3,000 is offered each year to support a postgraduate student at the John Curtin School of Medical Research travelling to overseas conference/s of relevance to human genetics.

Within this School much of the current research is considered "of relevance to human genetics" and it is up to the applicant to make the case for relevance.

Applications should include;

- a) A one page proposal detailing the value of the proposed trip to the student.
- b) An outline of the proposed trip.
- c) Supporting evidence of invitations, conference registrations etc.
- d) Current CV.
- e) Recommendation by the supervisor.

Awardees are required to submit a brief report to the Director addressing the benefits the Fellowship brought to their postgraduate program.
